EXPLANATION 1

Adverb of Manner

What is an adverb of manner? Look at examples:

E.g.: He **quietly** <u>slipped</u> away.

The Adverb here is **quietly** which is telling the way or manner in which the action was carried out and the Verb is slipped which is telling: **How** did he slip away.

E.g.: She works fast.

The Verb here is <u>work</u> and the Adverb is **fast** and the question being asked is: **How** does she work? Other examples of Adverbs of Manner are – Honestly, Joyfully, Cunningly, etc.

EXPLANATION 2

Remember, fist conditional is divided in two parts: The first part contains IF and the other part contains WILL. FOR EXAMPLE: *If she comes, Mary will cook the dinner.*

If I have to choose, I will go with Elena.
