Difference between short story and poem

The word "poetry" comes from the ancient Greek verb "to create." While a short story is usually written in recognizable sentences, a poem is composed of lines, which may not observe the usual grammatical rules. Furthermore, short stories are organized into **paragraphs**, but a poem is made up of **verses**, or stanzas. In a poem, words are often chosen not just for their functional, prose meaning, but for their sound, or feel.

FOR EXAMPLE:

SHORT STORY

Once upon a time there was an old girl called Agatha. She lived in a dusty old house.
Agatha thought: I hate this place! I will leave Immediately!
When Agatha open the front door, the house collapsed over her.
